Apart from permanent job positions, tertiary students with an interest in technology and start-up can explore internship opportunities in the Career Fair. These internship placements include the "<u>Cyberport Digital Tech Internship Programme – Shanghai Stream"</u>, the Cyberport Startup Alumni Association "e+startup" internship programme, which enables interns to work closely with CEOs of start-ups, as well as the "<u>eHealth Record Internship Programme</u>" which involves working in the health informatics profession on various eHealth Record related projects by different technology vendors that supports public and private health care providers.
