Cyberport Follows Government's Lead in "Early Vaccination for All" Campaign Announces COVID-19 Vaccination Leave for Employees

Hong Kong, 31 May 2021 - Cyberport welcomes the Chief Executive's announcement to kick-off the "Early Vaccination for All" campaign, including the provision of vaccination leave for all government employees from tomorrow (1 June) until 31 August, offering them a day of vaccination leave for each vaccination dose received, as well as appeal to other enterprises to provide similar arrangements. Cyberport fully supports the Government's announcement and will offer its employees a day of paid leave for each COVID-19 vaccine dose, from 1 June until 31 August, to encourage vaccination among its staff and to give them sufficient time to recuperate after getting vaccinated.

Dr. George Lam, Chairman of Cyberport, said, "Getting vaccinated is of utmost importance in our anti-epidemic efforts and is the key to helping our community get back to normal. At Cyberport, we hope to play our part in boosting the vaccination rate at this critical juncture to build a protective shield in Hong Kong as soon as possible."
