- 7 All material containing in the Confidential Information shall remain the property of JLL. JLL shall retain all right, title and interest in and to the Confidential Information. No licence under any trademark, patent, copyright, or any other intellectual property right, is granted or implied by the disclosure of any Confidential Information.

- 8 Notwithstanding anything in this Undertaking to the contrary, JLL does not make any representations or warranties of any nature whatsoever with respect to any information disclosed, including, without limitation, any warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose or against infringement, the accuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information and shall incur no liability to the other or any other person resulting from the use of the Confidential Information.
- 9 The undersigned acknowledges that in the event of an unauthorized disclosure or any breach of this Undertaking by the undersigned could cause irreparable injury to JLL, the damages incurred by JLL may be difficult if not impossible to ascertain, and that JLL may seek injunctive relief as well as monetary damages against the undersigned that breaches this Undertaking. The undersigned will pay all costs incurred in enforcing this Undertaking, including attorney fees, to JLL.
- 10 Upon expiration of the period of confidentiality, or sooner upon written request of JLL, all Confidential Information in the possession of the undersigned shall be returned to JLL or destroyed, at the option and instruction of JLL.
- 11 This Undertaking shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("HKSAR") and the undersigned agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of HKSAR.
