New Cyberport Job Portal “iTalent” Calls for Jobseekers

Hong Kong, 3 May 2021 – Cyberport has launched its new integrated I&T talent acquisition platform “iTalent”, providing career opportunities for young people with aspirations to join the I&T industry, especially this year’s fresh graduates. New job openings continue to be added to the platform by companies from Cyberport’s FinTech, Smart Living, and Digital Entertainment and Esports clusters, covering technical positions such as data analysts, full stack engineers, and AI researchers, as well as positions in business development, digital marketing and multimedia graphic design. Jobseekers, students and graduates can look for full-time, part-time jobs, internships and freelance opportunities on the platform. Eric Chan, Chief Public Mission Office of Cyberport said, “Cyberport has been working in tandem with the Government’s efforts to promote the development of innovation and technology and is committed to nurturing more excellent digital technology talents. After hosting successful career fairs for the industry in the past seven years, we noticed the demand for talent from our community companies has increased dramatically as they continue to scale-up, and while many of our start-ups are looking for the right professionals to boost their businesses, they are burdened by the costs and strain on human resources during the hiring process. Building on our experience, we have developed ‘iTalent’ with the support of our community start-up GetLinks, providing a sustainable solution to finding talent for the I&T ecosystem.”

“iTalent” has received support from government departments, technology giants and tertiary institutions in Hong Kong, and will enable over 1,650 Cyberport community companies to match suitable talents with job vacancies in a cost-effective way. To meet the needs of jobseekers, the platform will offer features including job search, job recommendations and reminders to help them find the right job. They can generate their CV from “iTalent” and download it as a PDF. Jobseekers can use the profile strength meter to gauge how robust their profiles are. The platform will also provide practical employment information such as tips on job interviews and experience sharing from participants of the internship programmes, as well as free learning resources from three technology giants, namely Amazon Web Services, Google and Microsoft. These resources will help jobseekers enhance their capabilities, enabling them to obtain their dream job, while streamlining the process of recruitment and improving effectiveness. In the future, the platform will gradually include more career and training programmes to benefit jobseekers. Cyberport will work with the Employees Retraining Board to provide short-term work placements and organise the Cyberport Digital Tech Internship Programme (CDTIP) to help IT talents gain practical experience.

The strategic partners of “iTalent” include the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer and InvestHK. It has also received support from tertiary institutions in Hong Kong including City University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University, Hong Kong Shue Yan University, Lingnan University, the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the Education University of Hong Kong, Hang Seng University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, the Open University of Hong Kong, the University of Hong Kong and Vocational Training Council.
